This event is a great opportunity for SACA members to participate in a gallery showing of fine ceramic art. This show is open to all SACA members and all ceramic artwork is welcome that demonstrates creative use of color, form and texture.

SACA members can see the JCC gallery space and speak with the JCC curator and SACA shows chair on September 26 form 5:30 pm to 6:30 pm. This will be the time

to ask questions, learn how to display your work and how to market the event. The gallery is always open during the JCC's operational
