Multiple submissions are allowed, with the fee applicable per person rather than per item. The exhibition will be curated by the JCC. Applications can be submitted on the SACA website from noon on October 1 to midnight on October 15.

This event is a great opportunity for SACA members to participate in a gallery showing of fine ceramic art. This show is open to all SACA members and all ceramic artwork is welcome that demonstrates creative use of color, form and texture.

Applications will be accepted from noon on October 1 through midnight on October 15. The JCC will notify you after November 1, 2024 if any of your pieces have been selected for the show.
